Kindness Bingo


Challenge your preschool families to some Kindness Bingo! Share the sheet on the next page, how many can they do? Why not share next week or take photographs to share with the wider church family.



Primary School Children




This time tomorrow....

Use the Kindness bingo sheet to think about how you live your life. You can use this or you can write your own ideas into the Kindness jar




An A-Z

Use the letters to spell out words - Bible, Kindness, Forgive.


Discuss what this means in practical terms and how they can do it in their everyday life.






Comic Time




If God was on TikTok!
